This form will allow you to ask AFNIC to remove the anonymity status of an individual holding of a domain name registered with restricted publication and for the extensions operated by AFNIC, such as : *.fr, .pm, .re, .tf, .wf et .yt.*

AFNIC will study your request with regard to the information you are providing, as soon as possible and will disclose the data in case of identical or similar to:

- Trademark already registered protected in France,
- Other distinctive signs already registered (name of the company, signboard, trade name protected in France, domain names),
- Already existing title protected by French intellectual property rights (copyrights),
- Surname or pseudonym.

AFNIC analysis will be essentially based on sign similarities and not about websites contents.

In case of refusal, the other procedures intended by AFNIC's naming Charter (obtaining a summary order injunction by a judge or submit a case with the empowered Alternative Dispute Resolution Bodies) can be applied.

## 3. Nature of information provided

The data that would be sent to you are « personal details » as defined by the French Data Protection Act, Law n°78-17 of January 6, 1978.

This information is sent to you on a strictly confidential basis.

If AFNIC accepts your request, the personal details relating to the domain name holder concerned will be e-mailed to you. That e-mail itself is likewise protected by confidentiality of correspondence.

## 4. Commitment of the applicant

The applicant undertakes to not use the data for other reasons than those mentioned in this form (and/or appendixes if needed).

The applicant also undertakes to keep the personal details confidential and not to divulge them to any other person except on the instructions of a proper authority.

The applicant also undertakes not to hold AFNIC liable for the personal details sent.

## 5. Date and signature

As required by the French Data Protection Act of January 6, 1978, as amended («the Act »), you are given notice that the information you send us is necessary for consideration of your request, and will be handled. Details marked \* are compulsory: failure to provide them will prevent your request being considered. The information collected from you will be handled by the person responsible (which is AFNIC – l'Association Française pour le Nommage Internet en Coopération) for the purpose of examining the Personal Data Disclosure Request sent to it under the Naming Policy for the extensions operated by AFNIC. The data recipient is AFNIC's Legal Department. You are entitled under the Act to object on legitimate grounds to the handling of your details, and/or to query and access details concerning you and to insist on their correction.
